PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT AGAINST HENRY "ENRIQUE" TARRIO AND SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT AGAINST PROUD BOYS INTERNATIONAL, LLC

Pursuant to D.C. Superior Court Civil Rule 55(a) and this Court's January 27, 2020 Order ("the Order"), Plaintiff Metropolitan African Methodist Episcopal Church ("Metropolitan AME"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully moves for entry of default against Defendant Henry "Enrique" Tarrio ("Tarrio") and Proud Boys International, LLC ("PBI").

I. Introduction

Because Tarrio failed to timely respond to a validly served complaint, the Court should enter a default pursuant to Rule 55. Metropolitan AME personally served Tarrio with the Complaint on January 5, 2021, and has photographic evidence of that service. By order of this Court, Tarrio was also allotted more than two weeks beyond the requisite twenty-one days to respond to the Complaint. Notwithstanding the Court's *sua sponte* grant of additional time, Tarrio has failed to file a response—or even appear—in this matter. Accordingly, an order of default against Tarrio is appropriate and should be entered forthwith.

Additionally, because Tarrio is an officer of the Proud Boys fraternity (the "Proud Boys") and therefore an appropriate agent for service on PBI—and because, as discussed in our motion for entry of default against PBI filed February 5, 2021, PBI has also failed to timely respond to the Complaint—the personal service of the Complaint on Tarrio is a further reason for default to be entered against PBI.

I. The Court Should Enter a Default Against Defendant Enrique Tarrio

Pursuant to Rule 12 of the District of Columbia Rules of Civil Procedure, defendants in a litigation must file a responsive pleading within twenty-one days after being served with a summons and complaint. D.C. R. Civ. P. 12(a)(1)(A). Once a party has failed to do so, "the clerk or the court must enter the party's default." D.C. R. Civ. P. 55(a)(1). Under the Rules, and as this Court has acknowledged, Tarrio was required to file his responsive pleadings by January 26, 2021. To date, he has failed to do so.

On January 4, 2021, Metropolitan AME filed its complaint (the "Complaint") against Tarrio and other defendants. *See Metropolitan African Methodist Episcopal Church* v. *Proud Boys International, L.L.C., et al.*, Compl. Metropolitan AME served Tarrio with the summons and Complaint through personal service on January 5, 2021 as he was released from police custody.

On January 4, 2021, Tarrio was arrested in D.C. and charged with one misdemeanor count of destruction of property in connection with the burning of another D.C. Black church's Black Lives Matter banner on December 12, 2020. Jennifer Steinhauer, et al., "Leader of Proud Boys, a Far-Right Group, Is Arrested as

Tarrio was also charged with two felony counts of possession of a high capacity feeding device. *Id.* He allegedly possessed two high capacity firearm magazines in D.C. at the time of his arrest, which was two days before the attack on the U.S. Capitol. *Id.*

On January 27, 2021, the Court issued an Order in which it addressed, among other things, Tarrio's failure to file a responsive pleading within the requisite twenty-one days, and directed him to file a motion for leave to file a responsive pleading on or before February 12, 2021. *Metropolitan African Methodist Episcopal Church* v. *Proud Boys International, L.L.C., et al.*, Order at 5 (Jan. 27, 2021). The Court made clear that absent the filing of such a motion for leave, Plaintiff could proceed by filing a motion requesting that a default be entered against Tarrio. *Id.* Despite being given an additional seventeen days to respond, Tarrio has yet to file a responsive pleading—or even a notice of appearance—in this action.

The deadline for filing a responsive pleading has long passed; so too has the Court's extension permitting Tarrio an opportunity to explain his delay. Given Tarrio's failure to file a responsive pleading within the deadlines provided by the Rules and this Court, a default should be entered against him.

II. The Court Should Enter a Default Against Defendant PBI

On February 5, 2021, Metropolitan AME moved for entry of default against Defendant PBI after PBI failed to file a responsive pleading within twenty-one days of service of the summons and Complaint in this action. As the Court is aware, the registered service agent for PBI, Jason Van Dyke, sent multiple e-mails to the Court and to counsel for Metropolitan AME stating that he was no longer PBI's service agent and providing a variety of dates on which he claims to have formally resigned, including (a) January 4, 2021, the day the Complaint was filed, (b) January 10, 2021, the day he forwarded the Complaint to Tarrio, and (c) February 5, 2021, the day Metropolitan AME moved for entry

of default against PBI.² Mr. Van Dyke has since communicated by e-mail to counsel for Metropolitan AME that he filed paperwork with the Texas Secretary of State on February 10, 2021 to initiate termination of both PBI and an affiliated entity, Proud Boys of Texas LLC.³

Mr. Van Dyke's most recent communications and his representations make clear that, notwithstanding any subsequent efforts, PBI was an active entity both at the time of the events described in Metropolitan AME's Complaint and at the time of service. Moreover, resignation of a service agent does not become effective until at least thirty-one days after paperwork is filed. D.C. Code § 29-104.10(b); Tex. Bus. Orgs. Code § 5.204(a), (d). Accordingly, Mr. Van Dyke's most recent communication, which states that he did not resign as an agent of PBI until February 5 of this year, conclusively determines that he remained PBI's service agent when Metropolitan AME served the summons and Complaint on January 6, 2021. Service on Mr. Van Dyke on January 6, 2021 was proper.

For the avoidance of doubt, however, service on PBI was also properly accomplished by personal service on Tarrio on January 5, 2021. Tarrio was the Chairman of the Proud Boys at the time he was served with a summons and Complaint. Under Article I, Section 2 of PBI's Bylaws, PBI is part of the Proud Boys. Compl., Ex. 1 at Art. I, § 2. Accordingly, Tarrio is an officer of PBI and was a proper recipient for service.

For those reasons—as well as those provided in Metropolitan AME's February 5,

2021 motion—default should be entered against PBI.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Metropolitan AME respectfully requests that the Court

grant its motions and enter orders of default against Defendants Tarrio and PBI.

I do apologize for addressing my past correspondence to the Court directly, it was intended for the Clerk. I regret the error.

I tendered my resignation as registered agent for the LLC on January 4, 2021 due to Mr. Tarrio's failure to find a replacement agent and take control of the organization in November of 2018. I took the liberty of checking this morning to see if my resignation — mailed that same day — had been processed by the Texas Secretary of State and found that it had not. I send a new one — this time by fax — to the Texas Secretary of State this morning. A copy of both is attached. I have repeatedly informed counsel that I have nothing to do with the Proud Boys, have had nothing to do with them since 2018, and that all information in my possession points to the fact that they have sued the wrong entity. In fact, in my prior correspondence with the Clerk, I provided copies of several leads concerning LLC's in Florida — in which Mr. Tarrio has an ownership interest — which appear to be the proper parties to this suit.

Since it appears to be the only way to resolve this dispute, I will begin the process of dissolving said limited liability company permanently on Monday morning. It has no assets and has never had any assets.



I received your motion for entry of default in the mail today. I compliment your office on doing something I did not previously know was possible: turning a motion that is normally only several sentences long into one that is five pages long with thirteen exhibits. While I certainly understand that the COVID-19 pandemic has made things difficult on all of us, I find it abhorrent that some members of the legal profession are taking advantage of their clients during this pandemic by billing excessive amounts for legal work, copying expenses, and postage expenses (not one of my clients has ever received a bill for copying or postage). It is clear to me that more drastic action on my part is necessary to prevent your office from wasting the resources of both your client and the judiciary during the pandemic.

The attachments to this e-mail should provide a final remedy both to that problem and the deforestation caused by your office inundating me with documents which I am not authorized to receive on behalf of an organization which I have not been a part of since 2018, which I have no further desire to be part a part, and which I will not be representing again under any circumstances.
